Located in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, the College attracts a select group of students to study with faculty who are experts in their specialty areas. An affiliation with Penn Medicine Lancaster General Health guarantees that PA College students receive clinical access to one of the largest health systems in south central PA. When the Lancaster General Hospital was founded, its original charter stated it was formed for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a hospital for the treatment and care of the sick and suffering, and the training of nurses to be employed in such care. More than 100 years later, Penn Medicine Lancaster General Health continues to fulfill this mission through Pennsylvania College of Health Sciences. Throughout its more than 100-year history, the College has grown from one nursing program to over 20 health science and nursing programs; from a private home for 40 students, to a dormitory for 240, to an all-commuter campus; and from a handful of students to an enrollment of over 1,800.
